Visuals help autistic children build communication and ease transitions.

Consider implementing these in your teaching



Explain things clearly



Describe exactly what they need to do and why they are learning that to help them understand the process



Allow extra

Tasks may take longer to complete so provide extra time

Conside all communication needs

Pupils may find it easier to communicate with signs or PECs. Accommodate all communication needs and encourage children

to find their best method
